How do I apply to the Graduate Programs in Biological Sciences at the University at Buffalo?

When are application materials due?

- MS and PhD Programs: **January 2**
- MA Program: applications are reviewed on rolling basis until **June 30**

Where do I obtain an application?

- To access the online application, go to <http://bit.ly/1qL8eem>
- Select the program of interest from the dropdown menu and check the box if you are not a US citizen or permanent resident.
- Click "Review Application Form" to view and edit the online application.
- At the bottom of the form, you can save your application for future editing or submit it for review.

What documents are required for online submission?

- Completed application form
- Copies of all college or university transcripts
- Personal statement
- Names and contact information for three instructors or supervisors who have agreed to write letters
- GRE scores (Institution code is 2925 and Department code is 0203)
 - *No standardized test scores are required for **MA applicants** who earned a Bachelors degree in a life sciences discipline at UB and graduated with a GPA ≥ 3.2*
 - *Other professional exam scores, such as an MCAT or DAT, may be submitted in place of the GRE for **MA applicants** who do not meet the above criteria*
 - *GRE scores are optional for **BA/MS applicants***
- Application fee (\$75.00)
 - *Fee waivers are available for masters applicants with a GPA ≥ 3.0 . Please apply at <http://www.cas.buffalo.edu/staylonger/>*

What additional information is required from international applicants?

- TOEFL scores (Institution code is 2925 and Department code is 35)
- Copy of biographical page in passport
- Graduate International Financial form
